**Celebrate Architecture** is a one-day design symposium, held each Spring in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. A group of internationally recognized architects spends the day with Louisiana architects, students, and the public, presenting their work and discussing their approach to design.

Over the years, Celebrate Architecture has brought in 60 internationally recognized architects from all parts of the country and Canada. Each year focuses on a common theme found in the work of each of the participants.



**Celebrate Architecture** is held in the Manship Theater, at the Shaw Center for the Arts, in downtown Baton Rouge, overlooking the banks of the Mississippi River. The Shaw Center was awarded an AIA National Honor Award.
